

Forbairt Trialacha don Ghaeilge – Léirmheastóirí

Mar chuid dá obair leanúnach ar fhorbairt trialacha, tá an Foras Taighde ar Oideachas (FTO) ag bunú painéil de ghairmithe oideachais chun obair ar bhonn ócáideach (measta ag 20-30 uair an chloig i 2019-20, le roinnt obair breise má oireann sin). Iarrfar ar bhaill an phainéil a dtuairimí a thabhairt ar roghnú téacsanna/léaráidí agus ceisteanna do thrialacha Gaeilge ag an bunleibhéal. Is cianobair a bheidh i gceist, agus beidh ar bhaill an phainéil ríomhaire le M.S. Word agus nasc idirlíon maith a bheith acu. Iarrfar ar bhaill an phainéil comhaontú rúnda a shíniú ag an tús.

Is cóir go mbeadh ard-inniúlacht sa Ghaeilge labhartha agus scríofa ag baill an phainéil, le saineolas i gcanúint amháin agus roinnt taithí ar na cinn eile. Tá sé tábhachtach chomh maith go mbeadh taithí ag iarrthóirí ar an gcuraclam teanga nua do bhunscoileanna.

Is iad na rátaí laethúla agus in aghaidh na huair ná €257 agus €43 faoi seach.

Irish Language Test Development – Reviewers

As part of its ongoing work on test development, the Educational Research Centre (ERC) is establishing a panel of educational professionals to work on an occasional basis (estimated at 20-30 hours in 2019-2020, possibly with some additional work). Panel members will be asked for their advice on the selection of texts/illustrations and of items for Irish language tests at primary level. Panel members will be expected to work remotely and must have access to a computer with Microsoft Word and good internet connectivity. Appointed panel members will be required to sign a confidentiality statement at the outset.

Members of the panel should have a high level of proficiency in spoken and written Irish, with expertise in one dialect and some familiarity with others. A familiarity with the new primary language curriculum is also important.

Daily and hourly payment rates are €257 and €43 respectively.
