

A LIST OF THESES ON EDUCATIONAL TOPICS COMPLETED AT UNIVERSITY COLLEGE CORK

This list of theses on educational topics completed at University College Cork was compiled from the library catalogue at the College and from calendars of the National University of Ireland. It covers the period from 1914, when the first thesis on an educational topic at the College was written, to 1967. Thirty-nine of the theses were presented for the degree of Master of Arts, three for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy. Copies of all master's theses and the most recent doctoral one (that of Halligan) are kept in the College library. The other two doctoral theses are kept at the headquarters of the National University of Ireland in Dublin. Most of the theses (thirty-two) were prepared in the Department of Education, ten others, though prepared in other departments, were thought to be of sufficient interest to educationalists to merit inclusion in this list.
